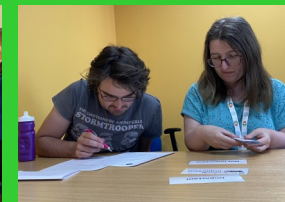

Coffee Shop

Our Coffee Shop is a friendly place to meet CLASP friends and staff. Our regular sessions include **Book Corner** and **Dancing To Music**. We have events and guest visitors, and you can find out what's going on in the area for people with learning disabilities. Also, if you have been a victim of hate or mate crime, CLASP staff will support you to make a report to the police and help you take the next steps to safety.

Independence Support

Some adults with learning disabilities don't get any statutory support from the council - this means they've been assessed as not needing any (or just a little) help. CLASP offers them 1-2-1 support so they can make better, informed choices and be independent. CLASP also signposts people to services when they need them - things like health, housing, welfare, benefits & general wellbeing.
